An exciting opportunity for a predominantly livestock GFW required on a mixed farm in the Cotswolds with arable, broilers, beef and renewable energy enterprises. We are seeking an enthusiastic person to join an experienced farming team assisting in all the various enterprises on the farm, being able to show initiative to work on their own and be able to handle responsibility. All training will be provided and we are used to working with placement students but now seek a permanent role for the right candidate.

Our broiler enterprise supplies 100k high welfare chickens per cycle to M & S Foods. We require someone to assist the poultry site & maintenance manager regularly within the crop cycle and helping with ongoing maintenance / refurbishment projects. No previous experience is necessary in broilers but a keen interest in good stockmanship is required as well as a proven ability to learn new skills.

We have a 150 cow pedigree suckler herd (Stabilisers) with all performance recorded progeny either finished on site or retained for breeding. The successful applicant would be a valuable member of the team assisting the beef foreman and regularly be involved with feeding / bedding up the cattle, helping during calving time and all cattle handling operations throughout the year including fencing (electric & boundary). We are increasing numbers so will aim to calve 170 cows in the spring of 2026. Herbal leys are utilised where possible as well as cell grazing techniques ensuring a happy, healthy herd.

Tractor driving roles would include carting livestock manures, topping, rolling, muck spreading, etc. We have good quality livestock equipment on site including 2 x forklifts, 28 ft hydraulic lowering cattle trailer, 16 dump trailer, spread-a-bale, Polaris Ranger, Suzuki KingQuad, etc. On the poultry site, modern computers run the sheds with quality ventilation, misters, biomass boilers, etc.

We are seeking a candidate with good practical / mechanical skills. There will also be the opportunity to be involved with the servicing / running of 4 x 200kw biomass boilers that provide heat for the poultry site.

Any ongoing training required will be provided for by the company. This is a great opportunity for someone to experience a large variety of tasks in the work, in a happy and safe workplace. We are looking for a permanent employee who is keen to settle into this area and interact well with the rest of the team here.
