You will ideally have an estates management or agricultural background or similar with land management skills and qualifications.

The role will include the use of machinery and plant, of which training will be provided prior to use. Tickets for excavator, saw, brushcutter etc are all desirable but aren't essential for a willing and enthusiastic candidate. Your salary would be dependent on the level of skill/experience you join us with and there is plenty of opportunity for progression through the business for the right people.

You will work as part of a small team and have access to a growing set of tools and equipment as well as the support and benefits that come from working within a growing consultancy.

On occasion this role may involve working away from home. The frequency of this is carefully monitored and this would be the exception to the rule.

- Vegetation clearance & felling using brush cutters and chainsaws.
- Tree protection fencing.

- Artificial badger sett creation.
- Footpaths.
- Swales.
- Bat & bird box installation.
