The Role:	<p>Job Title- Part-time Arable Data Assistan</p> <p>Job Description: This is a nearly entirely remote job role (95%+), whereby you will be assisting farmers with inputting their stubble-to-stubble arable rotations onto our mySoilCapital platform (similar to that of common FMIS systems such as Gatekeeper, MuddyBoots, Omnia etc). This is most commonly done via video call with the farmer, however sometimes it will be over the phone or e-mail. You will be liaising with up to 50 farmers, and will be given full paid training, with a specific point of contact in Soil Capital to assist you with queries and deal with administrative tasks. A working knowledge of arable agriculture and basic computer skills are of great advantage.</p>
