What is the BPP?

This internship is offered through **The Brokerage Placement Programme (BPP)**.

The Brokerage Placement Programme (BPP) connects talented students from underrepresented and working-class backgrounds with leading firms across finance, real estate, insurance, media and law. Applications are initially reviewed using a **blind shortlisting process**, with personal details removed to ensure fair and unbiased selection based on skills, motivation and potential. In some cases, the employer's name is also withheld at the first stage, encouraging candidates to focus on the role and business area rather than brand recognition. For this particular internship the employer's name is revealed and they are called **Mileway**.

About Mileway

Mileway is one of Europe's leading investors in **last-mile logistics real estate**, the warehouses that power next-day delivery. Every time you order something online, it likely passes through a distribution hub close to a major city. Mileway owns and manages over **1,700 properties** across **10+ European countries**, helping businesses move goods quickly and efficiently. Headquartered in London, they work with everyone from fast-growing local operators to global brands, all relying on well-located urban logistics space. So, as e-commerce expands, demand for space grows too.
