Talent to Teach FE programme offers students an exciting opportunity to gain an understanding of working and teaching in Further Education. This 40-hour placement will be delivered using a blended method of face-to-face and remote sessions; the students will have the chance to shadow a teacher, get involved in lesson planning, observing teaching and much more, whilst getting paid **£300 tax-free bursary** and receiving a **certificate** upon completion of the programme.

Talent to Teach FE is aimed at **second year and final year undergraduate and postgraduate students from any degree subject**. It is run on a term by term basis and tailored to the students' availability. All students will be matched with the most suitable provider based on their location.

This opportunity is ideal for any student wanting to increase their employability skills and enhance their CV.

Please note this programme is aimed at those students who have not considered teaching as a career. Please do not apply if you are already aiming for a career in teaching as this programme will not be suitable/ideal for you.
