

Short Paid Placement Opportunity in Further Education (Bursary)

Talent to Teach FE offers students an exciting opportunity to gain an understanding of what it is like to work and teach in Further Education. This 40-hour placement will generally take place on-site with a training provider but may also contain some elements of remote delivery.

You will have the chance to shadow a teacher, observe the many different aspects of Further Education, get involved in lesson planning, deliver your own lesson and so much more. On completion of the 40-hour work experience, you will receive a £300 tax-free bursary payment and a certificate.

Talent to Teach FE is aimed at second year and final year undergraduates and postgraduate students from any degree subject but unfortunately we cannot accept students already studying towards an education degree such as a PGCE.

It is run on a term-by-term basis and tailored to student and training provider availability. All students will be matched with the most suitable provider based on their location.

This opportunity is ideal for any student wanting to experience an exciting and diverse sector and explore the possibility of a potential new career choice, whilst also increasing employability skills and enhancing their CV.

THE PLACEMENT

Your placement will commence with an induction to the FE college/training provider. You will have a designated mentor, who will be your key point of contact during the 40 hours. You will have the chance to observe teaching, speak to both students and teachers, prepare and deliver a short lesson and more, giving you a real flavour of what it is like to work in the sector.

- The placement is 40-hours long;
- It is designed to suit your availability;
- You will receive full support whilst on your placement;
- You will increase your employability skills;
- You will enhance your interpersonal skills;
- You will gain transferable skills;
- You will have the chance to network with professionals;
- £300 bursary will be paid to you upon completion of your placement;
- You will receive a certificate of completion which can be evidenced on your CV;
- It will help you to make important decisions regarding your future; and
- You will gain invaluable experience which will help you in your future career.

REQUIREMENTS

- You must be either in your second year or final year of undergraduate degree studies or be studying towards a postgraduate degree; and
- You must be either UK citizen or an EU citizen, with the right to work and study in UK.

We are unable to accept international students due to the terms of the funding by the Education and Training Foundation (Department of Education).

Once your application has been received and a suitable placement established, you will be asked to provide proof of your eligibility.

The aim of this programme is to give you a very positive experience and a realistic insight into what working in Further Education is like.
