Château Reynier is looking for an Harvest intern to join us for the 2024 Harvest. The Harvest Cellar Intern works closely with Marc Lurton and the cellar team. We strive to provide a safe, educational, and enjoyable work environment while learning the day-to-day operations within the cellar to reach absolute wine quality.

This is a temporary position anticipated to commence end-August and is anticipated to last for approximately 2 months, subject to harvest conditions.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities

- Pressing
- Sanitation of tanks, equipment, etc.
- Conduct pump overs
- Topping and sampling as needed
- Bottling
- Maintain cellar cleanliness and organization
- Other duties may be assigned

QUALIFICATIONS

- Must possess a High School diploma
- Desire to work in the cellar with a positive attitude, a willingness to learn and prioritize attention to detail.
- Individual must have an interest in winemaking and possess a **valid driver's license** and be insurable by his school
